Dear Doctor Chavez:

The enclosed paper on "Educational Con-  
ditions in Mexico" has been submitted to me in con-  
nection with the proposed movement for helping to  
start the right kind of schools in that country.  
The first thing necessary seemed to be to inform the  
leaders of thought in the United States of the his-  
tory of education in Mexico and the present condi-  
tions there. If the people of these States are to  
help, they must first be correctly informed as to  
what Mexico has done for herself and how her people  
feel with regard to the subject.

Before publishing this paper we are extreme-  
ly anxious that it shall be historically correct and  
as fair as possible. May I, therefore, ask you to  
read it carefully, call my attention to any errors,  
either of history or deduction, and give me your full-  
est advice as to changes or amendments? You may  
mark the paper and number your corrections and sug-  
gestions, writing them on separate sheets, if you  
will be so good. In any case I shall be glad to hear  
your general opinion of the paper and especially whether  
you think it is calculated to do good. May I have  
the favor of a prompt reply and the acknowledgment

of the paper, which goes to you by registered mail?

vacation.
